SHIPPING.

• Since our last *Year Book* was published, an enumeration has been made by order of Parliament of all the ships owned and registered in the Dominion. The result shows, perhaps as correctly as possible, the state of our shipping interests. For although the precise wording of the return, viz., "owned and registered," excludes a good many ships registered in the Provinces, but not owned here, (which formerly appeared upon our nominal rell.) and also not a few which are owned but not registered, still a ship which is not both owned and registered in Canada can hardly be said to be in the fullest sense Canadian. We deem it necessary to say this because the totals of the return are not so great as those we gave in our last *Year Books*, which, it may be remembered, contained the first careful statement ever made as to the shipping of the Dominion. The figures compare as follows :--

Year Book statement-6,165 vessels of 859,829 tons, worth *\$33,619,157. Parliamentary return-5,822 '' 776,343 '' 23,583,062.
