In all, for the 16 months, the excess of revenue ever expenditure was \$3,467,522. These figures may not accurately represent the true state of the accounts. They are given, as we understand, at the end of the month, sometimes before all the charges are made. There is, we believe, a very considerable excess of Revenue over Expenditure, but that it will not be so large as would appear from the figures in the Gazette, all the charges not being entered. The excess is probably under two millions.
