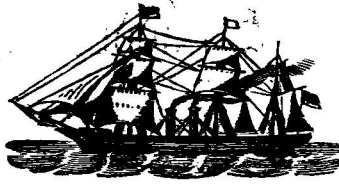

Cabin, \$70.00 and \$80.00. according to accommodation, Steerage, \$25.00. Children under 12 years of age, \$6.00 per head in After Cabin, and \$5.00 per head in Forward Berths; under 1 year, Free. In Steerage, over 1 year and under 12, \$2.00 per head; under 1 year, Free. Servants in Cabin, \$30.00.

Steerage Passengers require to provide their own Beds and Bedding, and Eating and Drinking Utensils.

FROM QUEBEC OR PORTLAND TO GLASGOW.

Cabin, \$60.00; Intermediate, \$40.00; Steerage, \$24.00. Children under 12 years of age, \$5.00 per head in Cabin; \$3.00 per head in Intermediate; and \$2.00 per head in Steerage. Under 1 year, Free.
