close of the year there remained in the warehouse 736,797 g.lls. against 43,631 galls, at the commencement, showing the production to have been slightly in excess of the demand. In Petroleum there was an increase both in consumption and export. The quantity taken for consumption was 4,516,490 gallons against 4,398,315 gall-, the preceding year, and the quantity exported 9,635,998 gall-, against 8,085,794 gallons in 1871-72.
