This line, we learn from the last report of the Minister of Public Works, is in operation; From Victoria to Saanich, Vancouver's Island, 15 miles. From Sasnich to Swinomish, Washington Territory, U.S., including 5 submerged cables 60 miles. From Swinomish to Matsqui, New Westminster, Hope, Yale, Lytton, Quesnelle and Barkerville 53 miles. There is also a branch line from New Westminster to Burrard's Inlet 10 miles. This line was assumed by the Dominion Government at the time of the admission of B. Columbia into the confede ation. Many repairs and restorations have been maace. The submerged cables

require partial restoration, and the line from Matsqui to Swinomish is not in a satisfactory state. 21 offices are in operation. The superintendent claums that every effort has been made to make the service efficient and economical, but the working is attended, with great difficulties, from the character of the country. scaliness of the population, distances between the offices and every high price of labour.
