Exchange papers pass free between publishers in Canada, and also to and from those in the United States and Newfoundland.

Papers from England via the United States are charged 2 cents each on delivery By Canadian mails free.

Pattern and Sample Post with the United Kingdom, British Colonies, and Foreign Countries.

The following are the regulations for the transmission of Samples and Patterns of merchandise between the Dominion of Canada and the countries mentioned below

1st. Samples of seeds, drugs and similar articles for delivery in the United Kingdom may be sent in bags entirely closed, pro-vided that such bags be transparent.

2nd Scissors. Knives, razor, forks, steel pers. nails, keys, watch machinery metal tubing, pieces of metal or ore, and such like articles are allowed to be forwarded by st as samples, to the United Kingdom, Germany and Belgium, provided they be packed to as not to injure the mails or the officers of the Post Office. They must be so put up as to be easily examined. Any packet jound insufficiently guarded will not b . f rwwaed.
