#### CAPITAL EXPENDITURE.

The total capital expenditure of the Dominion since Confederation, that is from 1867-68 to 1873-74 is \$46,544,211.

The total capital expend ture paid from

income during this period was \$13,475 074. The capital expenditure which is now commencing for the enlargement of the canals of Canada and the construction of the Pacific Railway will add materially to the public debt of Canada; but it is confidently anticipated that the corresponding increase to the wealth and population of Canada will be such as not to cause material if any add:tion to the burdens of the people, which are now very light, being among the lightest of any civilized nation of the earth.
