## CANALS.

## ST. LAWRENCE AND WESTERN LAKES.

This roate of navigation extends from Strate of Berle Jst, hverhoundland, to Duluid at the head of Lake Superior, 2,584 miles. There are 7 Dominion Canals on the roate and one United States, the Sr. Nor, 17500 miles iong. The total length of the Domine Canals on the roate is 7085-100 miles. Lockage 556 Jeet; No. of Locka 54.

The Lachine Canal from Montreal to Lachine is 986 miles from the Straits of Belle Isle, and is being extensively onlargoit. The locks for the new works will be 270 feet long by 45 wide, and the canal itself deepened to 14 feet.

The Beauharnojs Canal 13; miles from Lachiue, connecting Lakes St. Louis and St. Francis, with 9 locks and 9 feet of water on the sills, was thoroughly repaired in 1875. Traffic was only suspended oncoduring the sokaon and then only for \$2 hours.

The Cornwalt Canal, around the Long Sault Rapids, 19 32 miles from the Bequbarnois, and is of the same depth as that canal. Navigation on it was uninterrupted.

The Wilhamsburg Canals enabling vessels to ascend several short rapids are in all 12% inites long, all 9 feet deep, and in none was the navigation interrupted.

The Welland Canal, between Lakes Eric and Ontario, is 27 miles and 1.05 feet long in course of relargement in to the same age as the Lachine; meanwhile the present works are kept in good order, and navrgation was only sospended once for 38 hours botween & May and Bith Dec.

There is also a short causi of half a mile cat likewait the and bar separating Burington Bay from Lake Outario, and giving access to the Port of Hamilton for versils drawing 10 feet of walter.

There was expended on these canals during the facel year ending June 30th, 153, for construction, repairs and maintenlance, as follows:—
