The population of Egypt is now estimated at 17,000,000, and the equatorial regions of Africa at 44,000,000 Caffre-land north of the Transvaal is estimated at 1,000,000; Orange River Free State, +5,000; the Transvaal, 275,000; Natal (in 1875), 3 0,959 inhabitants; and Cape Colony, 1,148,462

America the following is extracted:—Greenland (1876) is estimated to have a population of 10,000; Nicaragua (1877), 300,000; Brazil (1872), 11,-108,219; Guiana (1*75). 342,300; Ecuador (1*75), 1,066,000; Peru (1876), 3,000,000; Chill (1875), 2,333 56*; Uruguay (1876), 445,000; Paraguay (1*76), 238,844.
