Columbia. The total value of Goods entered for Consumption according to the official return of the Commissioner of Customs for the whole Dominion is \$91,199,597, against a total of \$88.871.301 as shown by the above Table

Precisely the same remark may be made as respects the Table of Exports subjoined. For the whole Dominion, according to the Commissioner of Customs, the total amount for the Fiscal Year was \$79.523,667, while, according to the Totals from the monthly publications in the Canada Gazette, the figures, excluding British Columbia, are 171, 32,994.

It is right to observe that the monthly figures of the Gazette are subject to revision

and correction, but they may be accepted as approximately correct.
