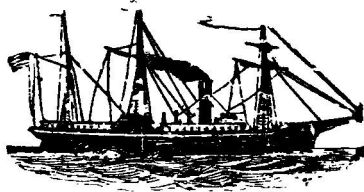


# QUEBEC AND GULF PORTS STEAMSHIP CO.

### NEW YORK and BERMUDA LINE.

Steamers of this Line, under Contract with the Government of Bermuda, leave New York for Bermuda, and Bermuda for New York, every alternate **Thursday**, and **Weekly** during the months of April, May and June.
