This fact, which is geed British exprobably at present more particularly the consequence of ports. the numerous financial transactions that take place between them, shows that the greater portion of the wants of the Colonies can be supplied by the United Kingdom. It has also been shown that, in proportion to their total exports, the exports to Great Britain are not keeping pace with those to foreign countries.
