CHAPTER IX.

MARINE AND FISHERIES.

PART I.-MARINE.

524. The special object of this Department is the protection Marine of our mercantile marine, and of the shipping that frequent ment. our coasts; it is, therefore, of the highest consequence that it should be made as efficient as possible, and it is gratifying to know that no pains are spared in order to bring about this result, and to provide security to shipping equal to that of the most advanced of countries.

525. An examination of the following table will give Number some idea of the progress made since Confederation. are shown the number of light stations, lighthouses, fog 1867whistles and fog horns in every year from 1868 to 1886 inclusive.
