The amount raised by taxation was larger in 1890 than Increase any year since Confederation, and was \$20,474,499 more than in amount raised by in 1869, in which year the smallest amount during the period taxation. was raised. Comparing the first and last years of the above period of twenty-three years, it will be found that while the total receipts have increased 170 per cent. the amount paid per head of population has only increased 75 per cent.; while the proportion to total revenue has decreased 7.33 per cent.
