The total foreign trade of British possessions has intrade with creased very largely since 1871; and, as will be seen from the following figures, the trade with foreign countries has increased in a greater ratio than that with the United Kingdom, which has been steadily decreasing. There was an increase, however, of 3.62 per cent. in the proportion in 1888, which was maintained in 1889:-
