PATENTS AND COPYRIGHTS.

The Patent

Office.

892. There has been a decrease in the business transacted by the Patent Office during the last two years, the receipts for fees in 1892 showing a decrease of \$248 during the year, and of \$7,314 as compared with 1890. There was, however, an increase of \$75,661 over 1868.

Duration of patents.

894. The limit of duration of a patent was formerly fifteen years, s. but by the Act 55-56 Vic., c. 24 (1892), this was extended to eighteen years, which period can be reduced by the applicant to six or twelve years on payment of a proportionate fee. In 1887 there were 2,596
