The lectures delivered by the Dairy Commissioner and his assistants have given information on the whole practice of dairying, from the cultivation of the soil, the growing of fodder crops, and the management of cattle, to the marketing of the finished products. Special instructions and demonstrations have been given to cheese makers and butter makers in nearly all parts of the Dominion.

During the year of the Dairy Commissioner's report, ending June 30th, 1893, no less than 375 meetings were attended and addressed by the Dairy Commissioner and his assistants. Particular directions and instructions were given from time to time
