Oleomargarine.

Butterine.

Similar substitutes for butter.

489. The following articles used by farmers in their business are admitted free :-

Animals-horses, cattle, sheep, swine and dogs, for improving stock.

Bees, Bones, crude.

Blast furnace slag.

Domestic fowls to improve stock.

Guano, bone dust and other animal and vegetable manures.

Indian corn for ensilage. Oil-cake and similar feeds. Rennet, raw or prepared.

Sawn lumber, not dressed or on one side only. Laths, palings, fence posts, &c. Seedling stock for grafting.

Seeds, beet, carrot, flax, turnip, mangolds,&c. Locust beans and meal for feed.

There are also on the free list articles so largely consumed by farmers and their families as tea and coffee. Sugar up to No. 16 Dutch standard is subject to a duty of only $\frac{1}{2}$ of a cent a pound and refined sugar to a duty of 114 of a cent per pound.
