EXCESS OF BIRTHS OVER DEATHS IN AUSTRALASIAN COLONIES, 1891-97.

According to the Census returns of 1891 for Canada, the birth rate in British Columbia was $23\cdot16$ per thousand of the population, and the death rate was $13\cdot94$ per thousand. In Manitoba the birth rate was $32\cdot53$ per thousand and the death rate $19\cdot36$ per thousand. In New Brunswick the birth rate was $27\cdot70$ per thousand and the death rate $13\cdot36$ per thousand. In Nova Scotia the birth rate was $25\cdot41$ per thousand and the death rate $14\cdot57$ per thousand. In Ontario the birth rate was $24\cdot50$ per thousand and the death rate was $11\cdot30$ per thousand. In Quebec the birth rate was $36\cdot86$ per thousand and the death rate $18\cdot91$ per thousand. In Prince Edward Island the birth rate was $24\cdot45$ per thousand and the death rate $12\cdot26$ per thousand. In the North-west Territories the birth rate was $24\cdot98$ per thousand and the death rate $7\cdot32$.

Manitoba is the banner province, having the second largest birth rate and the second lowest death rate, the result being that the prairie province has the largest excess of births over deaths.
