NOTES.
 GOLD—Placer Gold has been found and worked in many places in British Columbia which it is impossible to mark in detail. It also occurs in greater or less quantity in nearly all the streams running westward from the Rocky Mountains.
 COAL—The noted occurrences of Coal or Lignite in the Northwest Territories refer to natural outcrops or workings. They serve to indicate the widespread occurrence of these fuels. The same is true to a great degree in British Columbia.
