furnaces 7 were in blast and 7 were idle on the date named. Of the 14 completed furnaces, 10 were equipped to use coke for fuel and four to use charcoal.

The following table gives, 1st, the production in Canada of pig-iron; 2nd the importation of pig-iron, iron kentledge and cast scrap-iron for home consumption—the columns making up the total consumption; and 3rd, the percentage of home manufactured pig to the total consumption:—
