

CANADIAN CUSTOMS REGULATIONS RE EXPORT OF DEER,
MOOSE AND CARIBOU.

CUSTOMS PORTS.

Deer may be exported only from Halifax, Yarmouth, McAdam Junction, Quebec, Montreal, Sherbrooke, Toronto, Ottawa, Kingston, Brockville, Niagara Falls, Fort Erie, Windsor, Sault Ste. Marie, Port Arthur and such other ports as shall from time to time by the Minister of Customs be designated for the export of deer.

TIME LIMIT.

Exportation of deer is permitted only within fifteen days after the close of the season. No fish shall be exported within ten days after the close of the season.

NUMBER OF DEER ALLOWED TO BE EXPORTED.

No more than two deer or parts thereof may be exported by any one person in one season.

The exporter shall produce his hunting license to the collector of customs at the port of entry and receive permit for the exportation of the deer.
