In connection with the item 'Miscellaneous' it is to be noted that in the Census of 1901 where there were less than three establishments of a kind the details are not given separately but are lumped together. In the Census of 1891 large and small industries having been taken there was less likelihood of disclosing the details of individual business establishments, but in separating them necessarily in some cases the details of a single business, here and there, are disclosed. After 10 years no one will be incommoded.
