

THE CANADA YEAR BOOK 1907

The third volume of the Second Series of the Year Book is for 1907, in which the fiscal year ends March 31. The principal addition to this volume, besides the year's statistics, consists of a series of summary tables of field crops and live stock for 1907 compiled from a Post Office Census of the provinces of Ontario, Quebec, New Brunswick, Nova Scotia and Prince Edward Island. The principal table relating to railways has been recast to conform with the new classification of statistics in the last annual report of the Department of Railways and Canals. The notes of Events of the Year have been prepared by Mr. E. H. Godfrey and the tables by Messrs. James Skead and Joseph Wilkins.
