kinds and values of articles to be added to manufactures in those several tables, if so classified. If added to the exports of manufactures as given in table xcvi, p. 182, or in table civ, p. 245, the total values would be \$101,364,830 for 1903, \$99,248,026 for 1904, \$101, 310,252 for 1905 and \$121,287,839 for 1906. Added to the exports of manufactures to Britain in table xcvi the total value for 1906 would be \$62,277,538, to the United States \$43,124,911, and to other countries \$15,885,390; and the total increase in the three years from 1903 to 1906 would be 20 per cent. But of course the chief component value of these exports is that of raw material.
