¹ ACT OF 1907. The Territories, exclusive of Yukon, were in 1905 erected into the provinces of Alberta and Saskatchewan, and after the census of 1906 a Representation Act was passed which gave Saskatchewan 10 members and Alberta 7 after the next ensuing election, which came off in October, 1908. Saskatchewan (pop. 257,763) comprises the districts of Assiniboia 34,910, Battleford, 18,622, Humboldt, 23,903, Mackenzie, 25,998, Moose Jaw, 23,156, Prince Albert 19,782, Qu'Appelle 30,997, Regina 29,633, Saltcoats, 22,119, and Saskatoon 28,643, each with one member. Alberta (pop. 185,412), comprises the districts of Calgary 25,391, Edmonton 26,320, Macleod 25,961, Medicine Hat 22,323, Red Deer 32,001, Strathcona 29,658 and Victoria 23,758, each with one member.
