NOTE. The articles in tables cxiii and cxiv if added to the imports of manufactures in tables cvii-cx would give totals of \$169,797,211 for 1904, \$175,182,611 for 1905, \$197,100,033 for 1906 and \$249,072,649 for 1908. The imports of manufactures from Great Britain with the articles in these tables added would reach a total for 1908 of \$83,285,420, from the United States of \$128,002,989 and from other countries of \$37,784,240,—making an aggregate import of manufactures for the year of \$249,072,649, or nearly 70 per cent of all our imports.
