and values of articles to be added to manufactures in those several tables, if so classified. If added to the exports of manufactures as given in table xviii, p. 46, or in table xxvi p. 107, the total values would be \$127,496,448 for 1908, \$121,286,176 for 1909, \$143,642,353 for 1910 and \$143,483,083 for 1911. Added to the exports of manufactures to Britain in table xviii the total value for 1911 would be \$59,251,024, to the United States \$68,040,486 and to other countries \$26,191,578; and the total increase in the period from 1908 to 1911 would be over 12 per cent. But of course the chief component value of these exports is that of raw material.
