Measurement of the progress of dairying in Canada is possible by comparing the results of the census of dairy industries taken in 1911 with those of the previous census of 1900 and of the postal census of dairy products taken in 1907. The figures relate only to the production of factories and creameries, and do not include dairy butter made and sold by farmers. In 1900 the quantity of dairy butter so made was 105,343,076 lb.; the corresponding amount for 1910 is not yet computed. Table 4 shows by provinces the number of factories and creameries and the quantity and value of cheese and butter produced for each of the years 1900, 1907 and 1910.
