The articles in Tables 19 and 20 are usually grouped as natural products, as has been done in Table 7 under the heads of agricultural, animal, fisheries, forest and mineral produce, as well as in Tables 10 to 13. But by some authorities they are grouped with manufactured products, and they have been abstracted here to show the kinds and values of articles to be added to manufactures in those several tables, if so classified. If added to the exports of manufactures as given in Table 7, page 103, or in Table 13, page 157, the total values would be \$127,755,834 for 1908, \$121,727,539 for 1909, \$144,028,776 for 1910, \$143,938,754 for 1911, and \$144,822,716 for 1912. Added to the exports of manufactures to the United Kingdom in Table 7 page 103, the total value for 1912 would be \$61,348,779, to the United States \$56,097,570, and to other countries \$27,376,367; and the total increase in the period from 1908 to 1912 would be over 13 per cent. But of course the chief component value of these exports is that of raw material.
