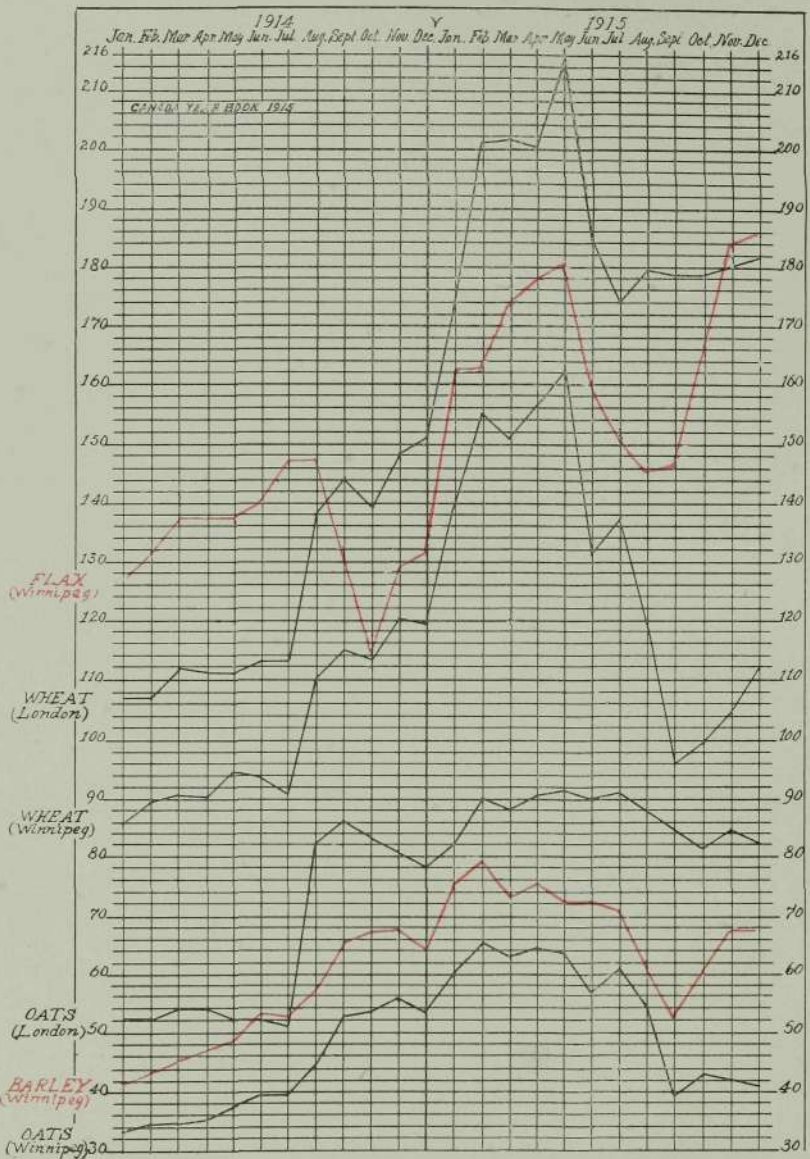


AVERAGE MONTHLY PRICES PER BUSHEL OF CANADIAN WHEAT, BARLEY,
OATS AND FLAX, 1914 AND 1915.



The horizontal lines indicate prices from 30 cents to \$2.15. The two higher black wheat curves indicate the average monthly prices per bushel of wheat (No. 1 Nor.) (a) at Winnipeg and Fort William and (b) at Mark Lane, London, England, the lower red curve of Barley (No. 3, C.W.) at Winnipeg and Fort William, the two lower black curves of Oats (No. 2, C.W.) (a) at Winnipeg and Fort William and (b) at Mark Lane, London, England, and the higher red curve of Flax (No. 1, N.W.C.) at Winnipeg and Fort William. (Wheat 60, Barley 48, Oats 34, and Flax 56 lb. per bushel.)
