

## AVERAGE MONTHLY PRICES PER BUSHEL OF CANADIAN WHEAT, BARLEY, OATS AND FLAX, 1915 AND 1916.

The horizontal lines indicate prices from 40 cents to \$2.70. • The two higher black wheat curves indicate the average monthly prices per bushel of Wheat (a) at Winnipeg and Fort William (No. 1 Nor.) and (b) at Mark Lane, London, England, the lower red curve of Barley at Winnipeg and Fort William (No. 3, C.W.), the two lower black curves of Oats (a) at Winnipeg and Fort William (No. 2, C.W.) and (b) at Mark Lane, London, England, and the higher red curve of Flax (No. 1, N.W.C.) at Winnipeg and Fort William.
