## Penitentiaries.

The statistics of penitentiaries given in Tables 38-41, are compiled from the annual reports to the Minister of Justice of the Inspectors of The report for the fiscal year 1918-19, in reference Penitentiaries. to the parole system, states that the total number of paroles granted during a twenty year operation is 11,846. A total of 10,434 men have completed their probation on parole and occupy positions in good citizenship to-day, and 701 prisoners are now reporting and have in prospect the completion of their probation on parole. The total delinquency for non-compliance with conditions of license is 437, or 3.69 p.c., and for subsequent conviction 273, or 2.30 p.c., making a total delinquency of 5.99 p.c.
