## IV.—COMMERCIAL FAILURES.

Commercial Failures in Canada, 1923.—According to Bradstreet's of January, 1924, the total number of Canadian failures reported during the calendar year 1923 was 2,915, with liabilities of \$50,623,425, as against 3,185, with liabilities of \$55,047,342, in 1922. In number there was a decrease in 1923 of 8·4 p.c. as compared with 1922, while the liabilities decreased by over 8·0 p.c. Dun's Review of January, 1924, gives the total number of Canadian insolvencies in 1923 as 3,247, as compared with 3,695 in 1922, whilst liabilities reached in 1923 the total of \$65,310,382, as compared with \$78,068,959 in 1922.
