Nora Scotia.—The Workmen's Compensation Act was passed in 1915, but only became effective on Jan. 1, 1917. During the eleven years between that date and Dec. 31, 1927, accidents to the number of 74,041 were reported to the Board, of which 62,253 were compensated as per Table 6. Prior to Jan. 1, 1920, medical aid was only furnished in special cases.

New Brunswick.—The Workmen's Compensation Act of New Brunswick was passed in 1918.
