## Section 16.—Quinquennial Census of the Prairie Provinces.

Under the Census and Statistics Act of 1905 and the Statistics Act of 1918, a census of the population and agriculture of the three Prairie Provinces was to be taken in 1906 and every tenth year thereafter, in addition to the decennial census of the whole Dominion. A census of the Prairie Provinces was, therefore, taken as of date June 1, 1926, and final results are presented in Tables 30 and 31.

The total population of the Prairie Provinces at the date of the census was 2,067,393, as compared with 1,956,082 in 1921, being an increase of 111,311 or  $5 \cdot 69$  p.c. The rural population increased during the quinquennial period from 1,252,604 to 1,312,155, and the urban population from 703,478 to 755,238. In considering the results of the census, it should be remembered that during the greater part of the quinquennial period, agriculture, the basic industry of the Prairie Provinces, was in a very depressed condition from which it has fortunately recovered.
