Graving Docks.—There are 5 graving or dry docks built and owned by the Canadian Government. The dimensions of these docks are shown in Table 10. The dock at Kingston, Ontario, is under lease to the Kingston Shipbuilding Company. The dock at Lauzon, Quebec, east of the old dock, is 1,150 feet long, divided into two parts (650 and 500 feet respectively), and 120 feet wide with depth of 40 feet at high water. It cost about \$3,850,000. Under the Dry Dock Subsidies Act, 1910 (9-10 Edw. VII, c. 17), several docks have been subsidized by payments of 3 or $3\frac{1}{2}$ p.c. per annum on the original cost for a given number of years, as shown in Table 11.

Expenditure and Revenue.—Table 12 shows the expenditure and revenue of the Public Works Department of the Dominion Government, for the fiscal years 1924-29. For the fiscal year 1929 the expenditure was \$19,948,576, as compared with \$16,596,414 in 1928—an increase of \$3,352,162, largely accounted for by expenditures for harbours and rivers, dredging and public buildings.
