Industrial Disputes in Recent Years.—In each of the years 1926, 1927, 1928 and 1929 the time loss in "man working days" from strikes and lockouts was less than in any year since 1916 and less than in most of the years back to 1901, when the record was begun. This was chiefly because there were no coalmining disputes involving large numbers of workers for relatively long periods of time. The number of strikes and lockouts in existence in 1930 was 67, as compared with 90 in 1929, slightly less than for any recent year, but the number of employees involved was 13,768 in 1930 and 12,946 in 1929, less than in any other year since 1915. Table 12 shows the number of strikes and lockouts existing in each year and the number beginning in each year back to 1901, also the number of employees involved, with the time loss in man working days in each year. The table includes figures as to coal mining and industries other than coal mining. The time loss in 1930 was less than in any other year on record.
