and coastwise shipping have shown a trend of marked expansion. Inland international shipping, on the other hand, has varied considerably from year to year without showing any definite trend. It is, however, significant of the importance of water-borne traffic on the inland rivers and lakes that the total tonnage of shipping entered and cleared was greater for Ontario ports than those of any other province in the fiscal year ended 1930 and in the latest year, 1931, was only slightly below the Pacific Coast province. This was due to the fact that the great bulk of the inland international shipping was through Ontario ports, while there was also a large tonnage of coasting trade through these ports. Quebec came third in total shipping, in 1931, followed by Nova Scotia and New Brunswick.
