Figures for January, 1925-31 are not comparable with those for preceding Januaries, because monthly records now being published include various classes of employees not included in the historical record for the 13 years 1912-24. In Table 21 will be found comparable figures of employees in the various Departments in March, 1930, and March, 1931.

Table 21, which gives statistics by Departments, with a further classification by principal branches where such are recorded, is inserted to give comparable figures for the latest months. In the month of March, 1931, the total number of employees in the enumerated classes was 45,581 and the total expenditure in wages and salaries for all classes of employees was \$7,895,591, as compared with 44,175 and \$7,443,404 respectively in March, 1930.
