As the U.S.-born population of Canada, according to the census, increased only from 77,753 to 80,915 between 1881 and 1891, it would appear that the number of permanent immigrants from the United States in these years must have been comparatively small. Sex and Conjugal Condition of Immigrants.—As shown by Table 3, the 25,752 immigrants who came to Canada in the fiscal year ended Mar. 31, 1932, included 11,988 males and 13,764 females, males constituting only 46.5 p.c. of the total. Male immigrants normally exceed female immigrants as is shown in Table 4.
