With further reference to the trade of Canada with countries other than the United Kingdom and the United States, attention is directed to Tables 8 to 39 (pp. 122-162) of the Condensed Preliminary Report on the Trade of Canada, 1936, published by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics. These tables show the trade of Canada in leading commodities with 96 British and foreign countries for the fiscal years 1935 and 1936.

Subsection 6.—Geographical Distribution of Canadian Trade by Continents and Countries.

Canadian Trade by Continents, 1936.—In the latest fiscal year exports increased substantially to both the United Kingdom and the United States, so that these two countries together took over three-quarters of our total exports. There were also increased exports in 1936 to South America, Oceania, and Africa, exports to the two last-mentioned regions rising to a greater proportion of total exports than in any of the other five years shown, largely owing to exports to the other leading British Dominions. On the other hand, exports to "Other Europe" and "Other North America" continued to decline and represented a smaller proportion of total exports than in any of the other years shown.
