Coal Consumption.—The sources of coal consumed in Canada in the calendar years 1911-36 are shown in Table 24, detailed figures of coal made available for consumption during 1936 are given in Table 25; the difference between the totals of the two tables in the same year is accounted for by the fact that coal received may be held in bond at Canadian ports and not "cleared for consumption" until required, while coal received in previous years may be taken out of bond (cleared for consumption) in a later year.
