expenditures on that work shown in Table 13, but the annual expenditures for dredging by the Department of Public Works, as shown in Table 18, are not included in the capital accounts. In the same category are the large annual expenditures for the construction of improvements to harbours and rivers throughout the Dominion by the Department of Public Works, as shown in the same table. Other expenditures on more or less permanent improvements, not taken into the capital accounts, are included in such items as "aids to navigation" in Table 17 and maintenance and construction of radio stations in Table 3 of Part VII of this chapter. The capital values of the harbours and properties administrated by the National Harbours Board are shown separately in Table 15 and expenditures on these properties have been eliminated so far as possible from the two preceding tables.
