Subsection 2.—Value of Agricultural Production and of Farm Capital

Value of Agricultural Production.—It is important to note that the figures of value of commodities produced on Canadian farms shown in Table 5 represent gross values of production. They are not net farm income as no distinction is made in crops used as materials for other kinds of production, such as feeding of live stock, and no allowance is made for the cost of production. In 1943 the yields of crops were not as satisfactory as in the preceding year but the output of live stock and live-stock products was greatly increased; consequently there was an over-all increase of 5.2 p.c. in the gross value figure. In 1944 every item showed an increase over the previous year with the exception of fruits and vegetables. The value of field crops showed an increase of 13.5 p.c., while the output of live stock and live-stock products increased 14.1 p.c. The over-all increase amounted to 12.4 p.c.
