of payrolls commenced only at that date, although, as already stated, the monthly statistics of employment are available from 1920. The decidedly upward movement of employment from the institution of the payroll statistics until the latter part of 1943, together with the relatively stable situation existing during 1944, are clearly illustrated in this graph, which also shows the continued expansion in the payrolls and in the average earnings during the year under review. It will also be noted, however, that the advances in the aggregate disbursements and the per capita earnings in 1944 were on a decidedly smaller scale than those reported in 1943 over 1942, being also less than those indicated in 1942 as compared with 1941.
