Causes and Results of Strikes and Lockouts.—In each year since the record was begun in 1901 the most important cause of strikes has been the demand for changes in wages but since 1936 union questions (chiefly union recognition, the discharge of workers for union activity or membership, the employment of union members only) have caused many strikes, resulting in a large proportion of the time
