Age and Marital Status of Contracting Parties.—The distribution of marriages by sex, age and marital status of the contracting parties is given in Table 37. About 93 p.c. of marriages are entered into by persons who have not previously been married. The average age at marriage of bachelors is about 28 years, that of spinsters slightly under 25 years. The average age of widowers at the time of remarriage is more than 20 years higher than that of bachelors, being  $50 \cdot 3$  years in 1940-42 and  $52 \cdot 0$  in 1944. The average age of widows at the time of remarriage is also more than 20 years higher than that of spinsters; it was  $46 \cdot 4$  years in 1940-42 and  $46 \cdot 9$  in 1944. The percentage distribution by age of widowers and widows who remarry is naturally altogether different from that of bachelors or spinsters.

Widows and widowers constitute about 4 p.c. and 6 p.c., respectively, of all brides and bridegrooms. Divorced persons constitute only  $2 \cdot 0$  p.c. of the total.
