## Subsection 2.—Debts of Provincial Governments

The average coupon rate of gross bonded debt of Provincial Governments decreased each year from  $4\cdot12$  p.c. in 1942 to  $3\cdot66$  p.c. in 1947. During these years also, the proportion payable in Canada only increased steadily, while that payable in New York showed a marked decline. Prince Edward Island had the smallest average coupon rate in 1947. Since publication of the 1948-49 edition of the Year Book the debt figures for the year 1946 have been revised.
