Subsection 3.-Manufactures Classified by the Purpose of the Products

Changes in the type and variety of Canadian manufacturing production are shown by the following table. The producers materials group accounted for $33 \cdot 2$ p.c. of the total gross production in 1947 as compared with $32 \cdot 5$ p.c. in 1939.
